To Qualify:

1. You must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and have been accepted at a Technical College or University.
2. You must be pursuing a degree in a field related to the building industry.
3. Along with the application, you must supply the following:
  - ✓ High School transcript
  - ✓ SAT scores
  - ✓ 3 Letters of recommendation (ie: teacher, administrator, minister, employer)
4. The recipient should demonstrate that he or she is ambitious and a hard-worker and has made an extra effort to achieve academically and personally.
5. The recipient should demonstrate that he or she is a mature person who has successfully managed responsibility.
6. The recipient who fails to enroll in or withdraws from their chosen school in the academic year of his or her award shall forfeit the scholarship.
7. The scholarship is awarded to a student based on a combination of academic record, participation in school and community activities, an academic recommendation, financial need and a student essay. No one of these items alone will dictate the selection of the recipient, but it is the sole discretion of the Scholarship Committee as to the weight each item will carry in the selection process.
